Students will need to pay the additional fees during the FIRST week of classes.

Daily Life in Pompeii: 200 € INCLUDES a mandatory field trip to Pompeii on Friday April 11th and Saturday April 12th

Art, Food, Fashion, and Wine: Creative Advertising of Italian Destinations: There is a mandatory field trip on Friday, March 14th the cost will be 30 €. Also, Students will be required to attend at least 1 Arty Friday organized by F_AIR. Several dates are available, please note that some Arty Fridays have a fee.

<u>Great Italian Opera:</u> payment directly only if going to the Opera (further information given by Instructor)

Cultural Introduction to Italy:

Domestic Architecture and Lifestyle in Renaissance Florence : mandatory Field trip to Pienza on Friday March 7th : 30 Euro.
