Language and Civilization - 12 Weeks

From Monday to Friday, this course offers:

Language Classes that allow students to progress in learning French (grammar, verb conjugation, spelling, vocabulary, approach to literary texts, written and spoken expression)

Organization:

- 2 hours per day in the afternoon (3pm 5pm / 5pm 7pm)
- 5 days per week
- Level test after registration
- Courses available at six different levels depending on the results of the level test
- Choice of timetable at the time of testing, depending on the level

Assessment of prior knowledge:

- Continual assessment: regular evaluation of work and progress
- Final exam: written papers, speaking test

An adapted pedagogy:

- The same teacher for the whole session; this allows for individual monitoring
- About twenty students per group

Phonetics Classes that allow students to improve their pronunciation and also their comprehension and expression skills.

Organization:

- 1 hour per day, 5 days per week
- For 4 weeks from mid-September to mid-October
- Classes only in the afternoon
- Courses proposed at 6 different levels depending on the test results and the student's mother tongue

Assessment of prior knowledge:

• Continual assessment: regular evaluation of work and progress

An adapted pedagogy:

- The same applied linguistics teacher for the whole session
- About twelve students per group

Three French Civilization lectures: Literature, Art and History.

Organization:

- The lectures last 1 hour
- Each lecture is held weekly
- The lectures are held throughout the session
- Lecture themes: French literature, French art history, the Château de Versailles

Assessment of prior knowledge:

Optional final exam reserved for the advanced levels
