GS Program Fees for this program include: tuition and registration fees for up to 6 credit hours, official transcript, airport pickup on designated group arrival days, orientation guaranteed housing, welcome and local cultural activities, 2-4 days of in-country excursions, use of GS cell phone handset (cost of calls is extra), on-site GS staff, GS staff on travel excursions, GS administrative and advising fees

If a student opts for a transcript of the School of Record, the University of South Florida, there is an additional fee of \$570 for 6 credits

Some courses have a lab fee. These vary from \$30 to \$200 depending on the course. Students will be billed for these separately, after their course selection

GS Insurance includes up to \$200,000 of medical coverage, medical evacuation, and repatriation insurance
