It is a fundamental course in accounting with emphasis on cost and managerial accounting. This course examines fundamental issues in cost and Managerial accounting such as basic cost terms and cost concepts, costing systems, cost behaviour and estimation, cost-volume-profit analysis and Break-even analysis, decision-making, relevant costs, Capital Expenditure decisions and cash flow analysis.
