Course Description

This course constitutes an initiation to the cultural heritage area of studies and research and aims to endow the participant student with a general culture and knowledge about the content of the universal cultural heritage. The course spreads its interest also on the artistic wealth accumulated through the ages as a result of human activity within the natural environment, namely constructing settlements and architectures, landscaping, and crafting; hence the interrelationship between the environmental and cultural heritage.

The finality of the course is to transmit to the students mainly a basic knowledge about the archaeological, the architectural and the artistic heritage. The students will also be initiated to the methodology of recording and archiving the cultural heritage, as well as to the modes of approach for the study and the preventive conservation.

During this course the students will additionally learn the record and the commentary of art works, a fundamental method of approach, research and study in Art History and Archaeology. They will also experience during field work the record of the heritage in situ in archaeological sites, in monuments and in museums which they will also visit.
