Course Description

The course presents advanced problems in design dealing with complex and environmental problems emphasizing the planning of large scale institutional and public buildings. The course also studies how the luminous and acoustic aspects of design can be manipulated to facilitate the activities to be sheltered and explores how they can control objective mood and convey symbolic values.
