Students develop conversational skills in order to cope with a diversity of situations in pairs and in groups.

Students are given texts of an intermediate level in order to practice the skills of:

- scanning,
- skimming,
- predicting,
- identifying the main idea,
- answering comprehension questions,
- decoding of unknown words,
- Enriching vocabulary.

- simple, compound and complex sentences;
