They also learn the basic procedures and techniques for a 2-person interview in a studio environment by rotating through all crew positions: Director, Ast. Director, Lighting Director, Vision Mixer, Sound operator, Camera operator, Floor Manager.

## **Course Aims and Objectives**

Through lectures and workshops, students learn the principles of Electronic Field Production (EFP) and Electronic News Gathering (ENG) and get a thorough training in video and studio production techniques.

## **Teaching Methods**

The course is delivered through a mixture of lectures, lab presentations, lab tutorials and practical exercises and project assignments.

#### **Course Teaching Hours**

42 hours (18 hours lectures/presentations + 24 hours laboratory work). The course is delivered during the Fall and Spring semesters in 14-weeks (3 hours/week).
