Course Description

Places students in environments suitable to the use of their communication skills – i.e. in a newspaper, magazine, radio or television channel, PR Consultancy or Advertising Agency. The length of time is minimum 45 hours of exposure/participation in the work processes in the appropriate medium, after which time the student must write a report about his experiences, for the supervising lecturer and also obtain the confirmation of the medium's immediate supervisor, or the medium's manager. Supervision of the students is the responsibility of the immediate supervisor in the relevant medium, and the supervising lecturer, who will track his progress and guide his internship period.

Course Aims and Objectives

The course aims at bringing the student in contact with professional media areas functioning in the market, with the purpose of familiarizing them with procedures, processes and realities in Press and Broadcast Media, as well as Public Relations Consultancies or Advertising Agencies. A further aim is to enable them to identify best, the area in which they would like to work and to give them the chance to create good contacts in the media market.
