Use of project management methods, project scheduling and control techniques, formal presentations and group dynamics in the solution of information systems problems. Development of a database to support the system. Alternatively, the project may consist of conducting research and producing only a dissertation. The research may be purely academic or it may investigate various software solutions used in the industry.
