Usually the project consists of designing and implementing a substantial piece of software and writing a dissertation. Alternatively, the project may consist of conducting research and producing only a dissertation. The research may be purely academic or it may investigate various software solutions used in the industry.

### Course Aims and Objectives

To give the student the opportunity to combine the knowledge he/she gained from a number of courses and put this in practice.

### Teaching Methods
