Course Aims and Objectives

This is a fundamental course in lighting and its interaction with visual perception and aesthetics. He basic functions of lighting are studied analyzed and critiqued as design elements. Lecture topics include color, light sources, measurement and control as they affect the interior environment. Students are asked to transfer this information to lighting plans and specifications and are encouraged to explore how the luminous aspects of space can control subjective mood and convey symbolic values.
