### Course Aims and Objectives

The course presents the tremendously large and important screen-process industry that is such a lively part of the field of commercial graphic communication, and the use of screen-printing as a central feature in art-prints and textile design. Students gain an awareness of the steps involved in constructing a printing board and frame, keying the screen, preparing inks or dyes, and printing the color runs – plus a list of various problems that might turn up and their solutions.

The course is delivered through a mixture of lectures, studio presentations, studio tutorials and practical exercises and assignments.
