Course Aims and Objectives

The course introduces students to the work of Landscape or Environmental Art which encompasses a wide variety of post-war art making. Lectures include the presentation of: site-specific sculptural projects that utilize the materials of the environment to create new forms; programs that import new, unnatural objects into the natural setting; time-sensitive individual activities in the landscape and collaborative, socially aware interventions. By exploring these approaches through examples of artworks and parallel texts, this course is intended to highlight one of the primary relationships that define the human condition: that of the individual's connection to the environment

Teaching Methods

The course is delivered through a mixture of lectures, studio presentations, studio tutorials and practical exercises and assignments.
