Course Aims and Objectives

The history and development of the English poem from the renaissance to modernism. The student will become versed in the major developments within English poetry as well as in major poetic figures. The periods covered will include the Metaphysicals, Augustinian, Romantics, Victorian and Modernist. The student will become acquainted with critical thinking on the poem and will be expected to form interpretations of poetic texts.
