- Foreign investments; finance of international trade and international payment.
- 7. International procedure.
- 8. ADR: International commercial arbitration.

#### **Course Aims and Objectives**

This course is designed to introduce students to the level aspects of international commerce and commercial relations. Students are guided through the basics of international trade law and trade organizations, the processes of dispute resolution, international sales contracts and the financing of international trade. The World Trade Organization will be studied in depth, as well as the relationship it maintains with some actors of international trade.

#### **Teaching Methods**

The course is delivered through a mixture of lectures, discussions, presentations, and problem-solving activities.

#### **Course Teaching Hours**

42 hours (30 hours of lectures, 12 hours of seminars/tutorials and student-led presentation/seminars). The course is delivered during the Spring semester in 14 weeks (3 hours/week).
