CAP.148 and the relevant case law; the main provisions of the Criminal Law, CAP.154 and the relevant case law; the main provisions of the Criminal Procedure Law, CAP.155 and relevant case law; the main provision of the immovable Property Law. CAP.224 and the relevant case law.

Course Aims and Objectives

The course continues from LAW-401 with more detailed examination of the most important items of Cypriot legislation concerning the following topics: contract law, the law of tort, criminal law, criminal procedure law and property law.

Teaching Methods
