- 3. Transposition of the accompaniment up of down a whole tone
- 4. Accompaniment to pieces of short forms (binary, ternary, songs, romances, arias etc).
- 5. Accompaniment to pieces for choir and small instrumental ensembles.
- 6. To supply an introduction to a song.
- 7. To improvise simple accompaniments
- 8. To sing a prepared song with a pleasant voice quality while playing an accompaniment on the piano.
