Course Description

This is a practical module covering selected music pieces of a variety of styles for chamber ensembles, mainly from Baroque and Classical Periods. The chamber groups comprise only music students from the Intercollege.

Topic Areas

1. For wind instruments the fundamental ensemble is the Classical Quintet (flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, French horn)
2. For string instruments the main ensemble is the String Quartet (1st and 2nd violin, viola, cello)
3. For voice to rehearse and perform songs with chamber ensembles of various types.
4. Chamber ensembles of various types and combinations including piano and voice.
5. Ensemble playing (feel of a uniform tempo, dynamics, articulation, phrasing, breathing etc)
6. Developing the ability to listen to their own music and the music performed by the other members of the group.
7. To enable the student to understand his/her role in the ensemble and to assess his/her contribution
