## **Course Description**

This is a practical module covering selected music pieces of a variety of styles for chamber ensembles, mainly from Baroque and Classical Periods. The chamber groups comprise only music students from the Intercollege.

### **Topic Areas**

- 1. For wind instruments the fundamental ensemble is the Classical Quintet (flute, oboe, clarinet, bassoon, French horn)
- 2. For strings instruments the main ensemble is the String Quartet (1st and 2nd violin, viola, cello)
- 3. Chamber ensembles of various types and combinations including piano.
- 4. Ensemble playing (feel of a uniform tempo, dynamics, articulation, phrasing, breathing etc)
- 5. Developing the ability to listen to their own music and the music performed by the other members of the group.
- 6. To enable the student to understand his/her role in the ensemble and to assess his/her contribution
