Course Description

These modules provide the opportunity for all students to study piano form the beginning of their studies. The lessons are provided once per week to each individual student and last fifty minutes each. The main emphasis is on the development of the skills, concepts and sensitivities for the performance of selected works by J.S. Bach, movements from Sonatas by J. Haydn, W.A Mozart, L. V. Beethoven and easier works by Romantic and Modern Composers. Students should also develop Sight Reading at the Piano and apply skills and knowledge acquired to their individual musical development.

The programme of studies is organized by the tutor according to students' requirements so that it will provide the development of skills, concepts, sensitivities and insights into piano music.

1. Scales: All Scales. Three octave major and minor, arpeggios, chromatic. thirds. broken chords. Diverging and converging
