Course Description

These modules provide the opportunity for all students to study piano form the beginning of their studies. The lessons are provided once per week to each individual student and last fifty minutes each. The main emphasis is on the development of the skills, concepts and sensitivities for the performance of selected works by J.S. Bach, movements from Sonatas by J. Haydn, W.A Mozart, L. V. Beethoven and easier works by Romantic and Modern Composers. Students should also develop Sight Reading at the Piano and apply skills and knowledge acquired to their individual musical development.

The programme of studies is organized by the tutor so that it will provide the development of skills, concepts, sensitivities and insights into piano music.

1. Etudes: Czerny op. 740 no 50, no 2, no 8, no 10, no 11, no 22.

2. Bach Preludes and Fugues- Part one- in c minor, g minor, f minor

3. Sonatas Mozart Sonatas in a minor K. 310, in C major K. 545,

Beethoven Sonatas in f minor no 1, in F

major no 6, in G major no 9. Sonata in A major op.120

Modern piece chosen by the tutor

During this module the student must study: one etude, one prelude and fugue, one Sonata and a modern piece. Suitable pieces of equivalent standard can be added to the above list at the tutor's discretion.

At the end of each Semester, students are assessed on the studied material.

At the end of the Course, students have an Exam which includes pieces of different styles and musical periods. Sight-readings exercises will be provided by the tutor.
